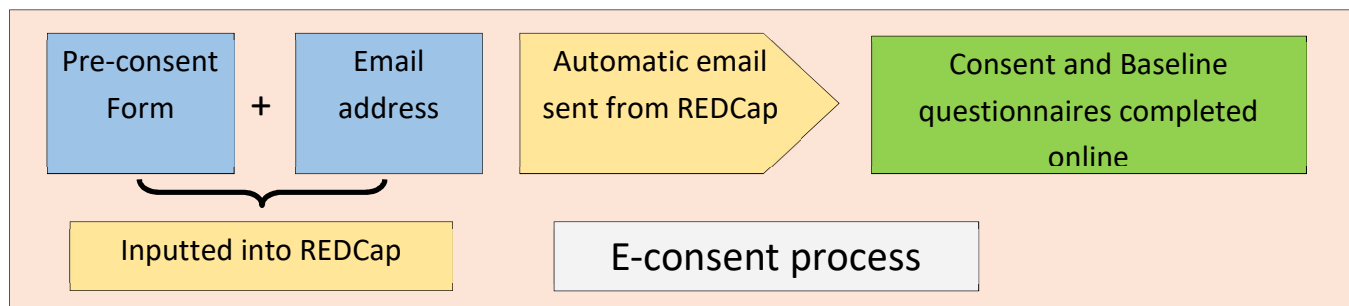
Statement from CI, Tim Theologis:

Key Updates

- **E-consent** is up and running. We require the pre-consent form and the parent/guardian's email address. An automatic invite to complete the consent form & baseline details will be sent once the data is inputted into REDCap.
- **Data entry** - GOAL questionnaire. When 2 options are selected for 'Walking Aid Required' always select the "best" option and notify the Study coordinator of this.

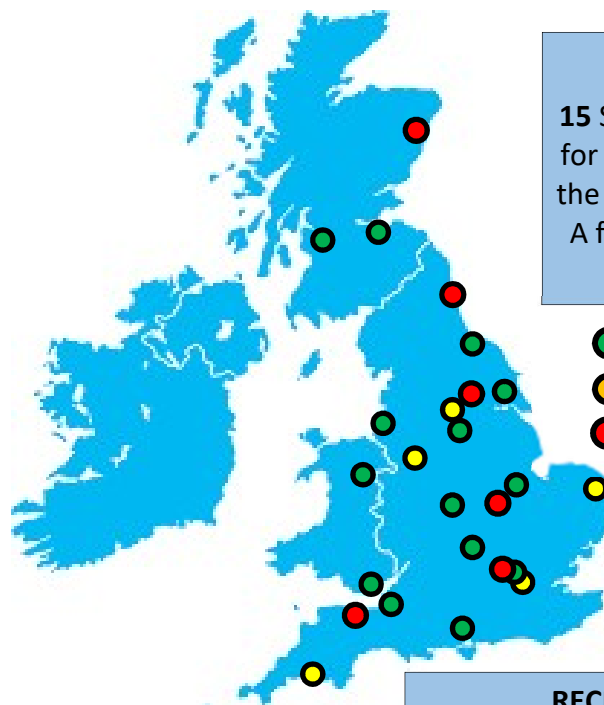
