Why is this study important?

- Artificial intelligence (AI) technologies are growing quickly, and many are aimed at healthcare.
- To develop healthcare AI, lots of patient information is shared with researchers from different backgrounds.
- By taking part, you will help us to understand public thoughts on sharing healthcare data for AI.

Why have I been invited?

You are eligible to take part if:

- You are 18 years old or older
- You are a UK resident or eligible for UK NHS care
- You have accessed NHS health care at least once since 2005
- You can speak the English language
