





#### LOGO – GENERAL USAGF PRINCIPI FS







The width of the end of the logo graphic is known as the 'X' dimension. This dictates the width of the clear area that should be left around the perimeter of the logo. Its measurement is determined from the graphic at the left edge and applied from upper/lower point, and the right hand side of the University logo block.





Minimum print size = 106mm wide

#### Minimum sizes for the combined logo/OU logo

When used in conjuction with the University logo, it is recommended that the minimum size reproduction should be observed.

The minimum reproduction size without the University logo are:

Minimum = 35 mm wide





Minimum print size = 109mm wide







#### The logo and descriptor line



The logotypes with descriptor have been specially drawn and spaced as a unit, and the relationship between these elements is fixed. It should never be re-drawn or altered in any way. Always reproduce it from the supplied master artwork.











The graphic devices can be used as an additional design feature, either in its 'solid' form or as a tinted background item.















Powerpoint Templates are available, with white or grey backgrounds to suit presentation/content.
