

This information sheet details the agreement between

Oxford Trauma & Emergency Care and WISE Collaborators

- Oxford Trauma intends to name individuals as collaborators on submitted manuscripts, within the constraints of house styles set by Journals, who can demonstrate they meet the WISE Collaborator Recognition scheme criteria.
- The collaborator will be as a minimum listed in the acknowledgement section and be sent a certificate, and where the journal policy allows, will be added as a collaborator in PubMed.
- Collaborators will be acknowledged only in the main clinical paper unless otherwise stated.

The criteria for determining an individual's collaborator status are:

Activity	Points	Evidence/ suggestions
Recruit a patient (consent and randomise)	2 per participant	- Centrally tracked
Deliver an WISE Supervised Rehabilitation Intervention session	1 per participant	- Centrally tracked

12 points and above = certificate and where journal policy allows be a PubMed searchable collaborator

Please note in order to be recognised as a collaborator on the paper you will need to keep your contact details up to date with the central trial team for the duration of the trial, even if you move away from the recruiting site. If the central trial team are unable to contact you at the time of publication in order to ask you to complete the required steps, you will not be eligible to be added to PubMed due to the established criteria.
